### Questions for Reflection

God heals and commands us to go out into the world and heal others. How are you a healing person? What situations around you are in need of healing? How can the church be an agent of healing?

**MISSION MOMENT:** Millions of people are in need of humanitarian assistance due to the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Larysa, her husband and her daughter escaped Kharkiv after spending four nights in the basement of their home due to bombings in the city. "Everyone wanted to travel out of Kharkiv. There were many people at the train station," shared Larysa. The family found shelter in a refugee centre supported by the ACT Alliance. "We are happy to have a place to sleep and where it is warm. It is safe here. I am glad our children are alive." PWS&D supports the Hungarian Interchurch Aid with an appeal issued by the ACT Alliance. The appeal will provide emergency food assistance, essential non-food aid, health care and emotional support to refugees and internally displaced people.
