Dec 4 *Second Advent Sunday* Give us peace in our relationships & in our souls, God, as we prepare to celebrate the birth of Christ.

Dec 5 We pray for Omar Haramy, Director of Sabeel Ecumenical Liberation Theology Center in Jerusalem, and Palestinian Christians as they work for justice and engage in peacebuilding.

Dec 6 Today marks 33 years since the École Polytechnique massacre in Montreal. On this day in 1989, 14 women were killed & others were wounded. We pray for healing & comfort for all who lost loved ones that day & for an end to the misogyny that leads to gender-based violence.

Dec 7 We pray for the development & implementation of stronger laws and policies to protect women & their rights.

Dec 8 We pray for the people at Hummingbird Ministries in Vancouver & we give thanks for their ministry.

Dec 9 We pray for the Continuing Education Grants Committee, as they meet at the national office of the PCC.

Dec 10 *Human Rights Day* We pray for individuals and organizations defending human rights in Canada and around the world. We pray for their safety and the safety of those they support and protect.

¹Mission Moment “Where is God in all of this oppression and injustice?” Upon hearing the anguished cries of Palestinian Christians, Palestinian clergy felt it was crucial to respond pastorally and remind them that God is the God of justice, the God who cares about the oppressed. These Christians need God’s hope. In 1989, Palestinian Christian theologians developed a theology that could be shared with fellow Palestinian believers. This led to the establishment of Sabeel Ecumenical Liberation Theology Center in Jerusalem, an ecumenical grassroots liberation theology movement. Presbyterians Sharing supports Sabeel and Director, Omar Haramy, in standing with the oppressed, working for justice and engaging in peacebuilding.

The Huron Perth Public Health website encourages everyone to “Layer up” to protect you, your loved ones and your community from viruses (COVID-19, influenza and colds). **Layers of Protection** reduce risk and help to prevent getting sick. You are encouraged to:

- Stay home when sick
- Get vaccinated with as you are eligible
- Wear a mask and avoid crowded indoor spaces
- Maintain physical distancing
- Wash your hands
- Screen for any symptoms and use rapid test kits
- Seek out anti-viral treatments, if eligible

Each layer adds protection. The more layers an individual uses, the more protected they are.
